

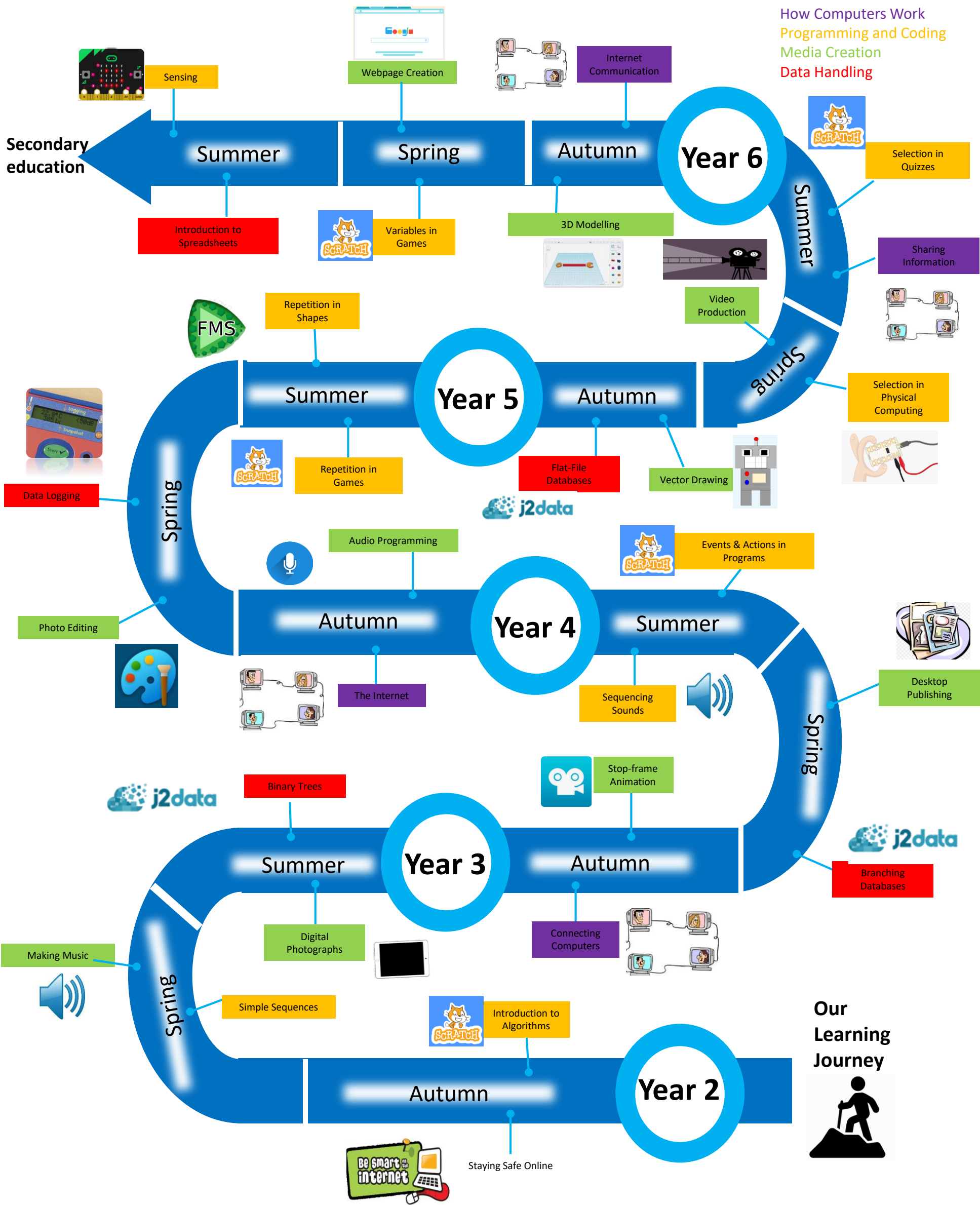


Computing Road Map
