

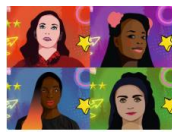


Music Road Map

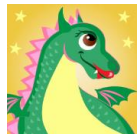

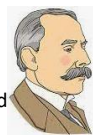

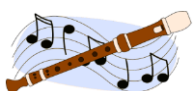
