Seasonal Colds and Covid-19 Cases in School

We have a number of children who are currently suffering from seasonal colds as well as other children who have Covid-19 symptoms and Covid-19.

I would like to thank the parents for keeping us updated with their PCR results and the co-operation and understanding that has been shown by the parents during this difficult period. We have a number of children absent who are awaiting PCR test results as a precaution due to close contact with positive cases which is helping to contain the spread.

If you feel your child needs to have a PCR test, there is a Walk In Centre at Glebe Gardens which you do not need to make an appointment for. They are returning test results within 24-48 hours.
