

Kit List

The children will need to be able to carry/pull their own cases so please be mindful of this when choosing and packing their case or bag.

Clothes are likely to suffer wear and tear and it will be cold and wet, therefore several changes of old clothes will be needed.

Please name all belongings clearly, even footwear.

- () Wellingtons.
- () 2 Sensible pairs of trainers.
- () Waterproofs - coat and if possible, trousers.
- () 2 tracksuit bottoms or combat style trousers are better for wearing during the day.
- () Jeans are fine for the evening but very hard to get dry once they are wet.
- () T-shirts and jumpers.
- () Fleece or warm coat.
- () Gloves, hat and a scarf.
- () Night clothes, dressing gown and slippers.
- () Extra socks and underwear.
- () Toiletries in named wash bag, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, roll on deodorant
- () For the girls, sanitary products if necessary and/or 'just in case'.
- () 1 big towel, 1 hand towel and a shower cap for girls.
- () Large plastic bag for dirty clothes.
- () Plastic bag for muddy trainers and wellies at the end of the week.
- () A small cuddly friend to take to bed if you wish.
- () Up to £6 spending money in a named purse.
- () Lip Salve/Balm is useful.
